## ORDINANCE 167

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALL THE RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST OF THE PUBLIC IN CERTAIN LANDS KNOWN AS A PORTION OF ELBERON AVENEUE, AS HEREIN DESCRIBED, IN THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 152 Entitled, "An Ordinance Vacating All the Right, Title and Interest of the Public in Certain Lands known as a Portion of Elberon Avenue, as Herein Described, in the Village of Loch Arbour, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey." is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent are herewith repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
