## ORDINANCE 175

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 67, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREFOR, AND SSPECIFICALLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 10, 22, 23 AND 34 AND ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES INCONSOSTENT THEREWITH" BY ADDING A SECTION THERETO RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF PARKING ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF ELBERON AVENUE FROM THE EAST SIDE OF OCEAN PLACE TO THE EASTERLY TERMINUS OF ELBERON AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that the Ordinance referred to in the title hereof is amended and supplemented as follows:

Section 1. Section 301 of Article 3, (Parking Prohibitions, limits and methods) is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

NAME OF STREET

SIDE

LOCATION

From the east side of Ocean Place

To the easterly terminus of Elberon

Avenue.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and publication and approval by the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey, as provided by law.
