REPORTS/DISCUSSION

- A. School Tax Issue Mayor Fernicola reported the Village is still waiting for a response from the State of New Jersey, Commissioner of the Department of Education. Mayor Fernicola stated in the middle of September the State advised the Village to serve the Mayor and Council of Ocean Township, which the Village has done. The Village anticipates an answer from the State in the next couple of weeks.
- B. Historic Preservation Ordinance Mayor Fernicola explained the Village of Loch Arbour Planning Board has adopted a Historic Preservation Element which was added to the Village's Master Plan. The Mayor and Commissioners agreed that a Historic Preservation Ordinance be prepared and be added to the Agenda for the next Commissioners Meeting for their consideration.
- C. Halloween Party The Borough of Allenhurst would like to invite the residents of the Village of Loch Arbour to their Annual Halloween Party on Saturday, October 29th at 1:00 p.m. The party will be at the Railroad Plaza Park. There will be hay rides, paint your own pumpkin and refreshments.
- D. Clean Ocean Action Fall Cleanup The Cleanup is scheduled for Saturday, October 22, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. Meeting place will be at the entrance of the beach at the end of Euclid Avenue.

PUBLIC HEARING

UPON MOTION of Mayor Fernicola, seconded by Commissioner D' Angelo, carried, that the meeting be opened to the public for comments.

Mary Farrar, Euclid Avenue, reported Mr. Parisi has had a heart attack, he is home and resting, but he will be going back into the hospital for another procedure.

David Den Bleyker, Euclid Avenue, stated regarding Resolution 2016-27, he believes the sand that was replenished must be at least 80% sand and 20% can be other matter. Mayor Fernicola responded the Army Corp of Engineers stated the sand the Village was replenished with complied with the specifications.

Mr. Den Bleyker, asked which homes in Loch Arbour are being demolished. The Mayor stated two homes in the Village have put in Requests for Local Zoning Determination for demolishing and reconstructing new homes at 329 Euclid Avenue and 305 Euclid Avenue. The Zoning Officer has approved both Requests. There has not been any Request submitted, to the Village, to demolish 101

Norwood Avenue. The Clerk stated a Request was submitted to the Zoning Officer for an addition to the 3rd floor of the home.

Mr. Den Bleyker, also stated in the New Jersey School Magazine it was reported the Township of Ocean High School went from a rank of 84 last year, and dropped to 120 ranking this year. He also stated his daughter is attending Rumson-Fair Haven High School and the Ocean Township School System will not provide him with a stipend for transportation to and from Rumson-Fair Haven High School. Ocean Township's reasoning for not giving the stipend is, they have the equivalent program for his daughter at the Ocean Township High School, which Mr. Den Bleyker does not agree with.

Mr. Den Bleyker, also had a conversation with the Mayor regarding the Village's Noise Ordinance.

There being no further comments, UPON MOTION, of Mayor Fernicola, seconded by Commissioner D'Angelo, carried, the meeting be closed to the public for comments.
